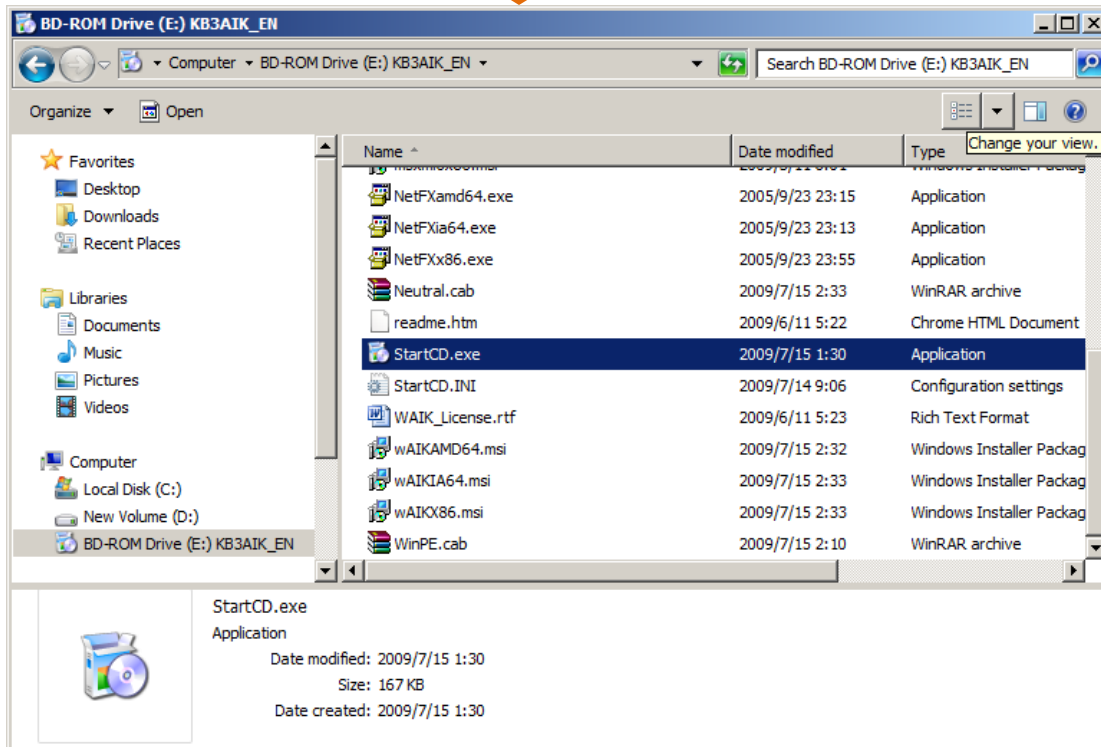
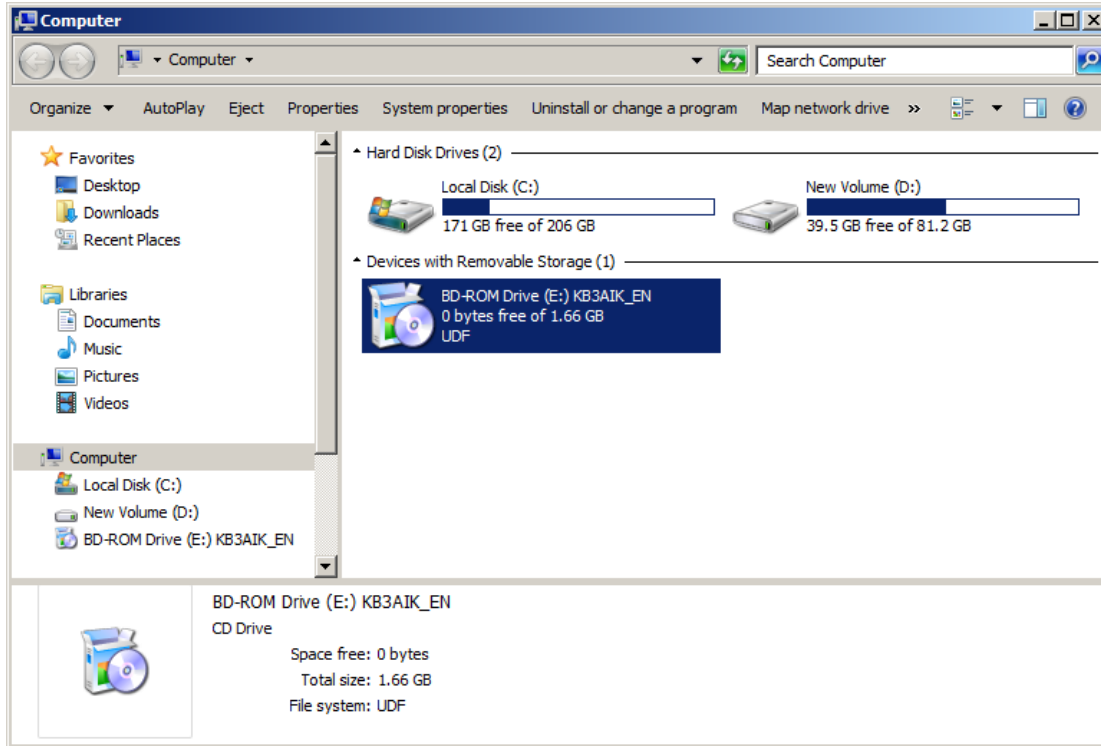
Symptoms

Sometimes users may fail to create a WinPE based bootable disk with EaseUS Todo Backup Free/Trial Edition, different error messages may pop-up in different environment, but according to our experience, most of them are caused by incorrect Windows AIK installation or misoperation when creating the bootable disk.

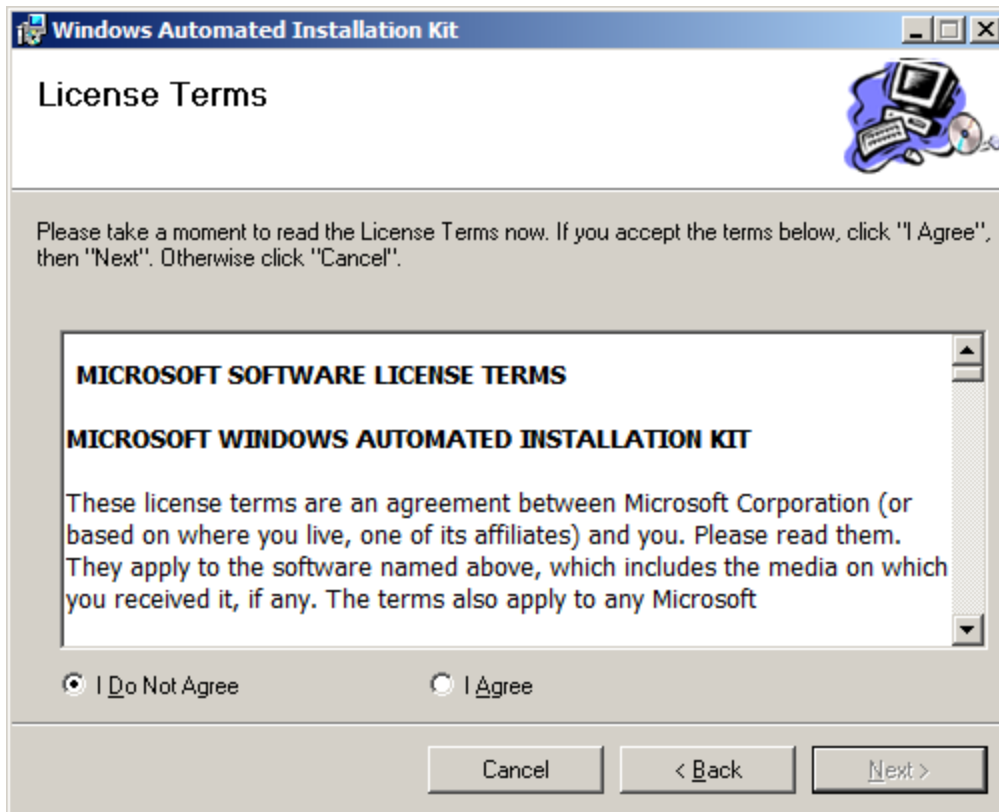
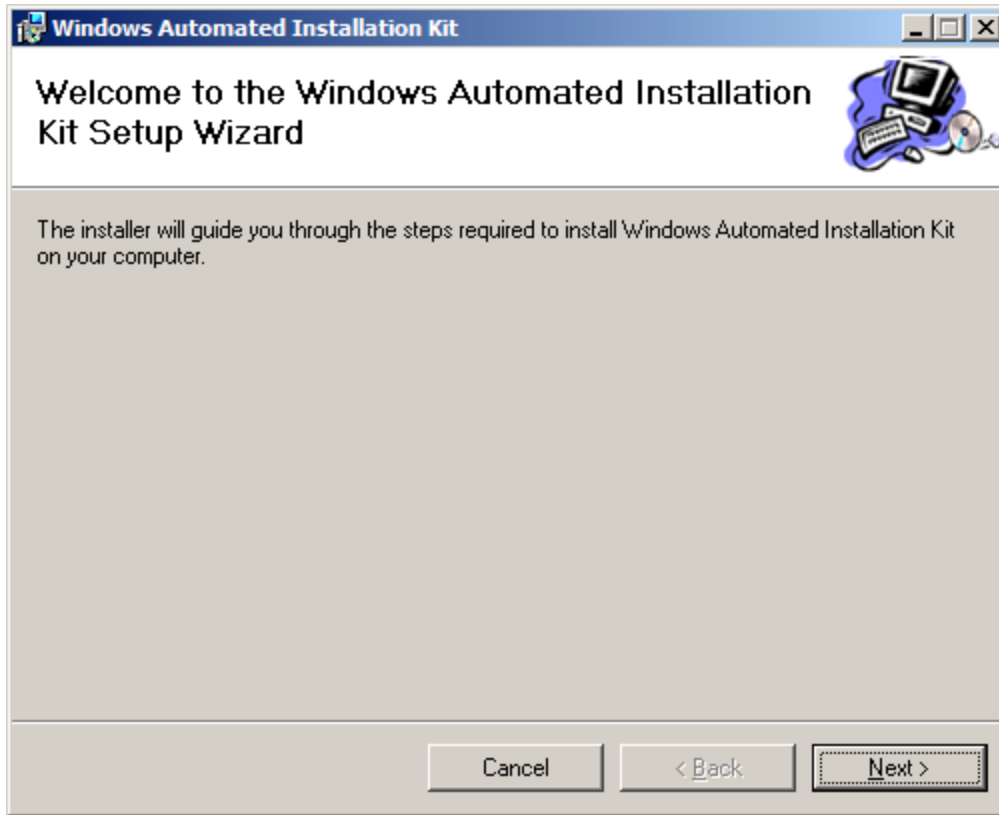

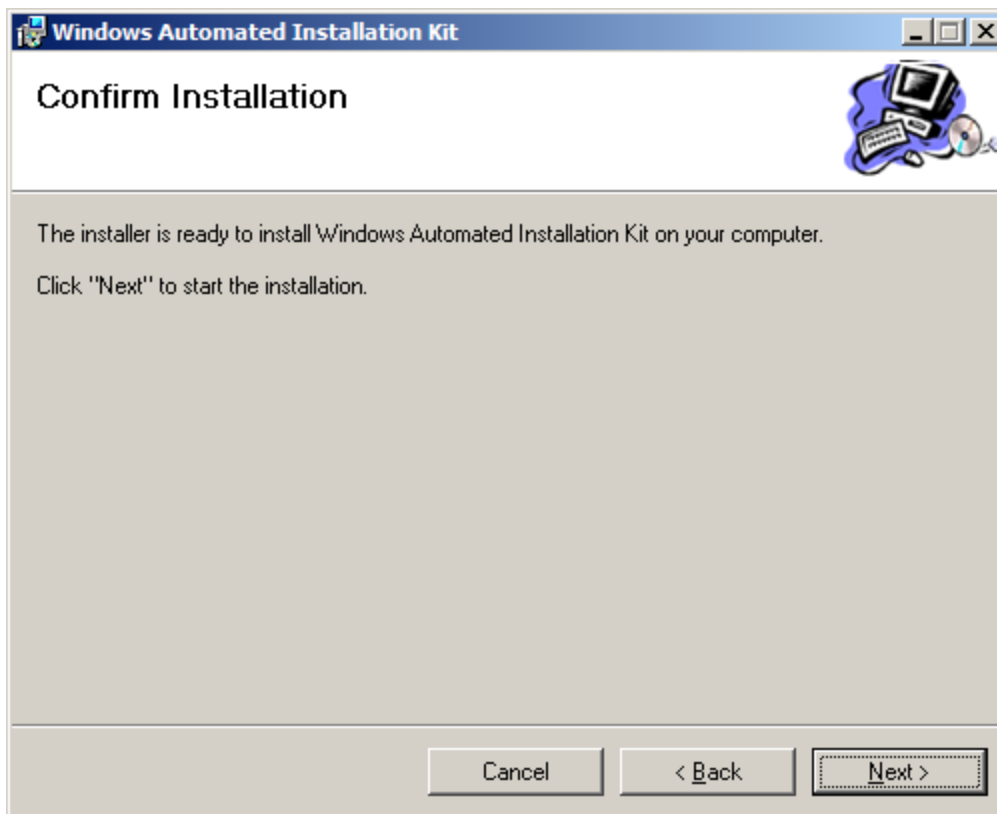
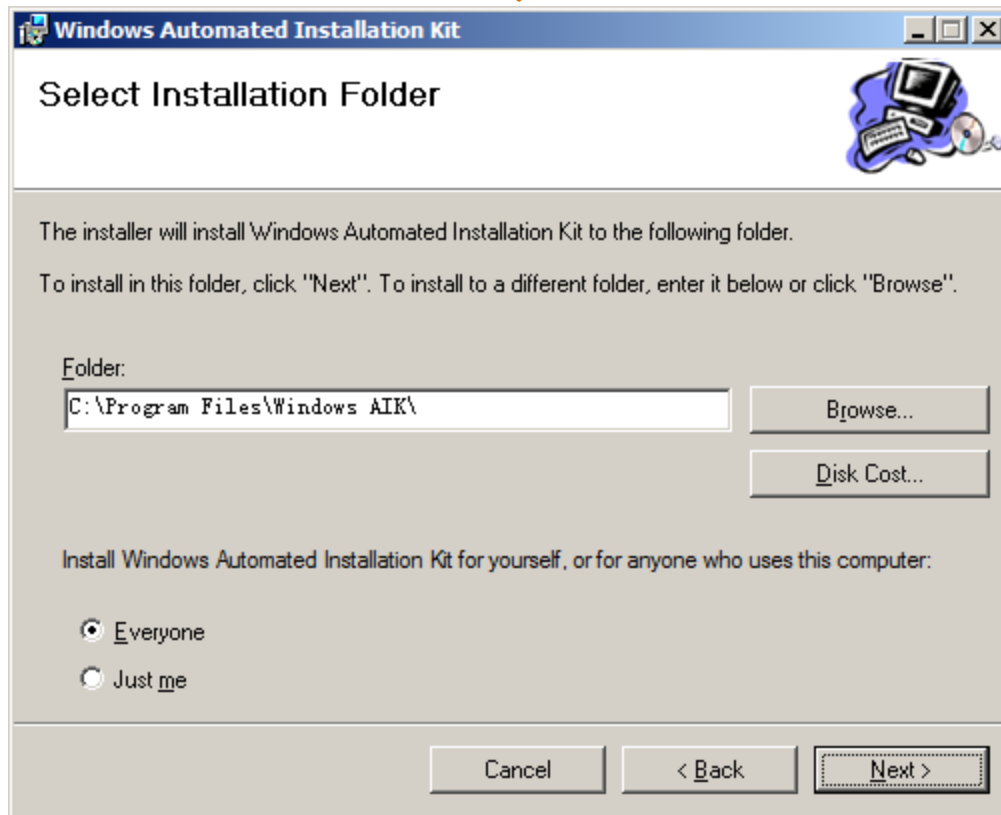
Part 2 Solution Steps

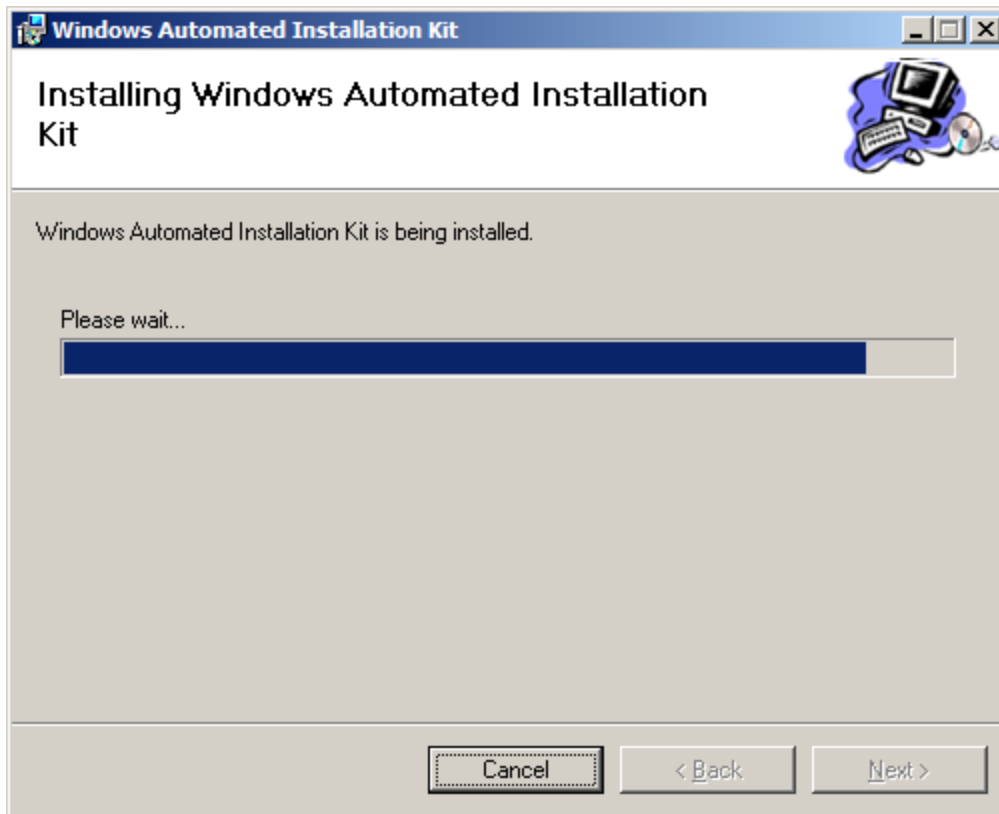
1. Download the [Windows Automated Installation Kit \(AIK\)](#) and burn it to a CD or mount it with a virtual drive tool to install it. Following these steps and options you will have Windows AIK installed at last.



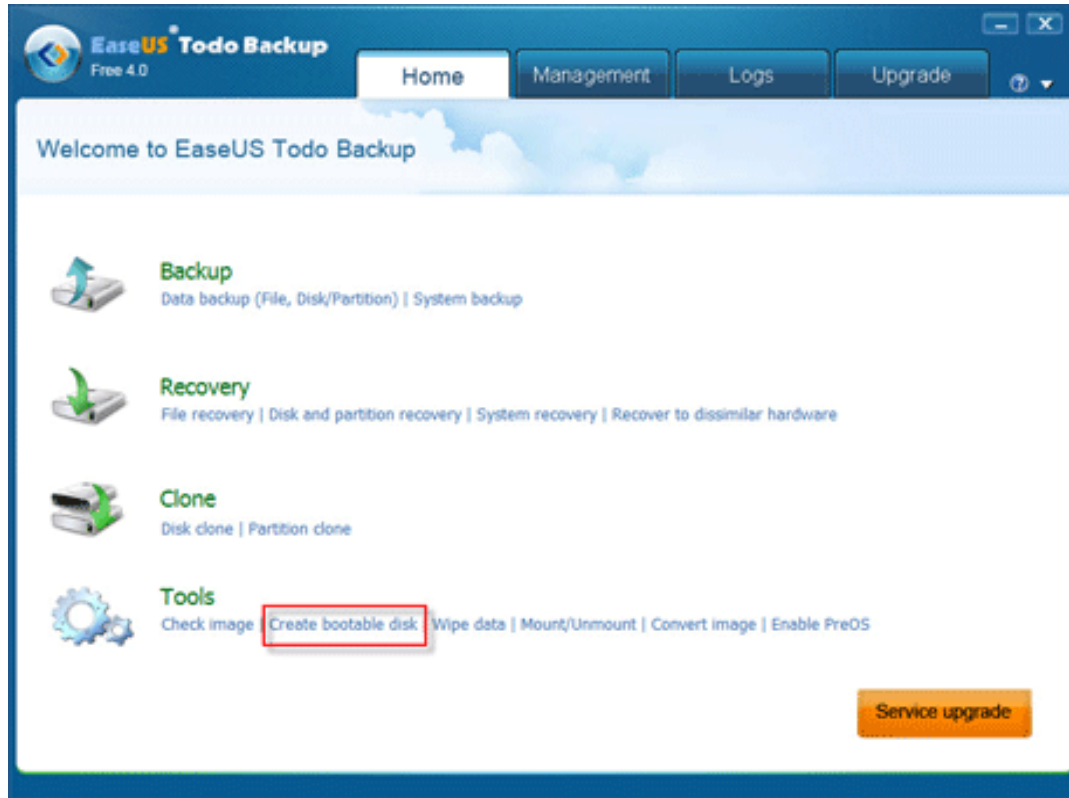








2. Run EaseUS Todo Backup Free/Trial, select "Tools" and then select "Bootable media builder".



3. Select Create WinPE bootable disk, click here.
